The website of the Foundation “Remembrance, Responsibility and Future” has been redesigned and expanded

Berlin, 20 April 2009. The new website offers a wealth of information on the priority themes of the Foundation and engaging insights into its funding activities. You will also find interviews with experts, background information and details of upcoming events in various theme-related dossiers – 70 years since the start of WWII, the situation of victims of National Socialism today, human rights, and payments to forced labourers under National Socialism. There are numerous examples of projects in the form of multi-media presentations, as well as details of the current calls for applications in each of the priority areas.

The completion of the payments to former forced labourers provided the opportunity to restructure the website and give it a new public face. The Foundation is now focusing on the second part of its mandate – to provide support to international projects. In remembrance of the victims of National Socialism, the Foundation works to promote human rights and understanding between peoples.

The Foundation “Remembrance, Responsibility and Future” operates in the following areas: a critical examination of history, working for human rights, and commitment to the victims of National Socialism.

Around EUR 8 million out of the income generated by the Foundation’s assets is made available each year to support mainly international projects in these three activity areas.
