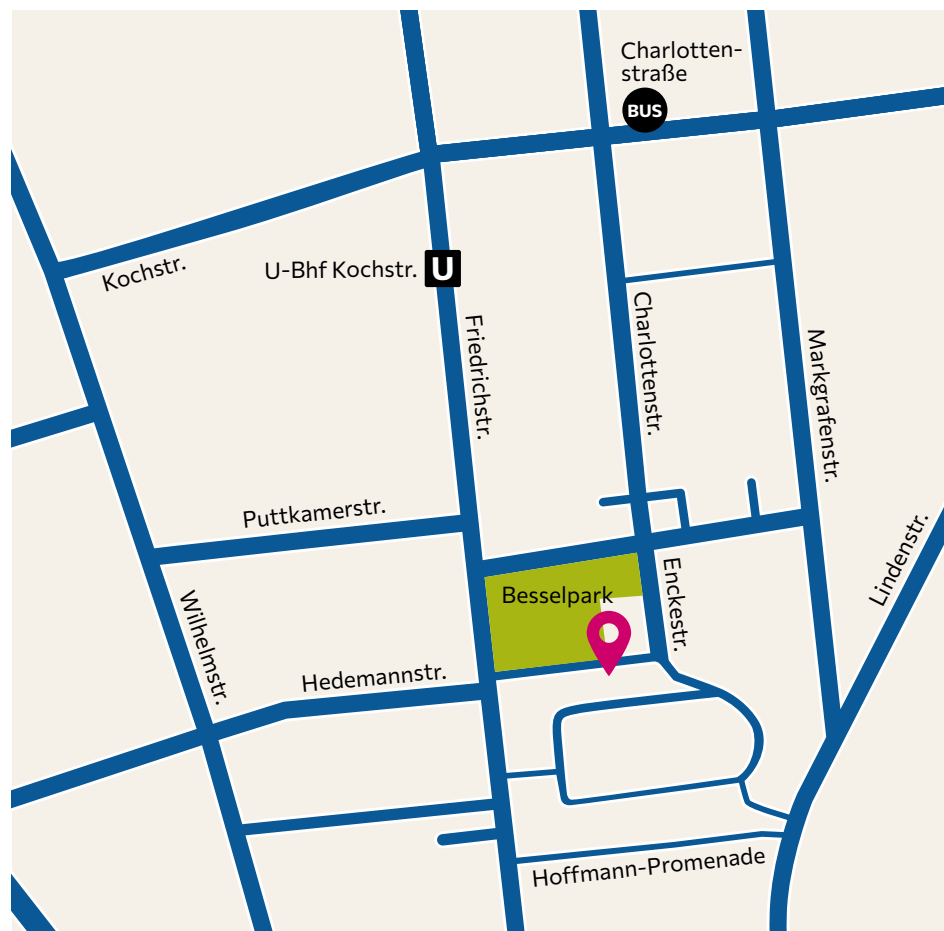

The theatre pedagogical cooperation project “stumbling” of the Schaubühne Berlin and the Piccolo-Theatre in Cottbus takes its very own look at the stumbling stones which remind us in almost every city in Germany that discrimination, persecution and the Holocaust took place right on one’s doorstep. 18 adolescents from both cities asked themselves the question: what does it mean to “stumble” over the stories of victims of the Nazi persecution? In their play, the young people develop touching images and thoughts from this experience, which they have brought onto the stage.</p> <p><i>On the panel, the two actresses Lina Zegenhagen & Pola Juniewicz will tell us about their experiences during the project together with the theatre pedagogical director of the Schaubühne Berlin, Mai-An Nguyen. 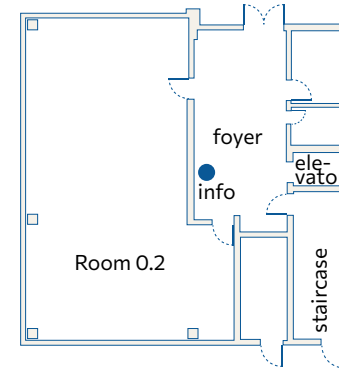

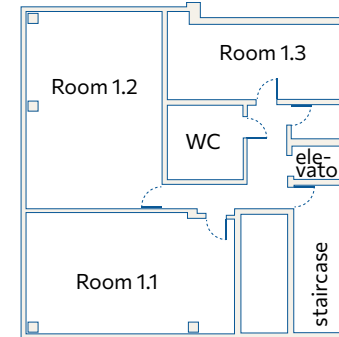


FLOOR PLAN

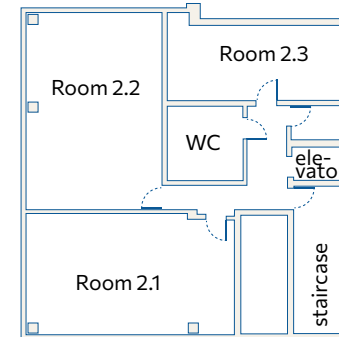
GROUND FLOOR
