

7–8 pm	PANEL TALK "MEMORYLANES – SHAPING TRANSNATIONAL YOUTH EDUCATION WITH LOCAL BIOGRAPHIES" (in English with simultaneous German translation) Opening up new ways of remembering is the core of the "MemoryLanes" project. Over a period of two years, young people from Germany, Poland and Serbia are dealing with Jewish life stories of the 20th century and making them tangible through creative interventions in public space. With this biographical work, they show how Jewish history can be understood as an indispensable part of European history and as integrated into the memory practices of urban and European publics. One of the biographies is that of Julian Gringras who was born in Kielce in 1911. On the panel, Emilia Więckowska and Nikola Snoch, two students from Kielce, will talk about their conversations with the grandson of Julian Gringras and the discoveries they made during their search. Together with them, Ninja Stehr and Nicola Andersson from Centropa will discuss the project on the panel. 


GROUND FLOOR




FIRST FLOOR
