3. Why do we process your data and on what legal basis is this permissible?

We process your data on the basis of a jointly implemented project in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. b) GDPR for the purpose of contacting the persons in charge of the project and, in the event of a positive application assessment, to implement the project with those persons.

Initially, your data on the website will be entered into our database as part of your application, and then be assessed internally. During this process, personal master data and contact details of the institution's project managers and authorized representatives are collected. Upon positive assessment, you will be requested to sign up on the website. You can register by entering your email address, a password of your choice and a username freely selectable. For registration, we use the so-called double-opt-in process, i.e. your registration is completed only when you have previously confirmed your registration via a confirmation email sent to you for this purpose by clicking on the link contained therein. The provision of the data mentioned above is mandatory. Any additional information during the registration process can be provided voluntarily.

4. Will third parties receive your data?

The following service providers may obtain knowledge of your personal data while performing their services for us: IT service providers, web hosts, developers, and agencies. The following supervisory authorities may receive data from us or inspect it: Federal Office for Central Services and Unresolved Property Issues (BADV), the Federal Audit Office as well as auditors.

5. Does any transfer to a third country outside the European Union take place?

No, data is not transferred to third countries outside the European Union.

6. Duration of storage

As a matter of principle, we erase your personal data if the purpose has ceased to apply and no statutory retention periods or any statutes of limitations prevent the erasure.

7. Rights of the data subject

- (1) You have the following rights in relation to us regarding your personal data:
 - The right of access to your personal data processed by us pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR
 - The right to rectification of inaccurate personal data pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR
 - The right to erasure of your personal data pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR
 - The right to restriction of processing pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR
 - The right to object to processing pursuant to Art. 21 (1) GDPR: If we process your data on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit. f) GDPR or for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit. e) GDPR and you can show grounds arising from your particular situation, you may lodge an objection. We will then no longer process your data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your reasons for not processing.
