

Dr Moritz Kilger

Co-Director of the Foundation “Remembrance, Responsibility and Future” (EVZ)

Dr Moritz Kilger, born in 1975, began serving as the Co-Director of the Foundation “Remembrance, Responsibility and Future” (EVZ) in July 2017. The main focus of his career has been on formal as well as non-formal education, organisational development, business and finance.

From 2012 to 2017, Moritz Kilger lead the Foundation European Youth Education Centre (EJBW) in Weimar, which uses Weimar as a place to tackle the question of “What strengthens democracy, and what weakens it?”

Previously, he was a fellow with Teach First Deutschland for two years, teaching at a technical school in Heidelberg. He also previously taught political science and history at a secondary school in Cologne.

From 2008 to 2009, Moritz Kilger worked as a management consultant with K.GROUP Business Development Services in Munich.

He studied political science, economics, history, and linguistics and literary sciences, and in 2007 he completed his doctorate in economics at the University of Cologne, focusing on financial market regulation in the EU.

Moritz Kilger is a member of the Advisory Board of the Ettersberg Foundation, and of the Nazi Forced Labour Documentation Centre in Berlin.
